### City Attorney

#### **Charter Section 8.1**

- Shall serve as the chief legal advisor of the City
- Shall advise the Council and other City Officials in matters related to their official powers and duties
- Shall supervise City Attorney's Office employees
- May recommend special counsel



### Purpose:

- Provide aggregate data and reports on work completed by the City Attorney's Office to show the types of data now being tracked
- Share with City Council and the Public some of what the City Attorney's Office does
- Explain some of the changes being made, like tracking data, since becoming City Attorney
- Provide privileged information about litigation in executive session



### Changes and Challenges

- Departure and Hiring of new Assistant City Attorney
- Departure and Hiring of new Legal Assistant
- Adopting Monday.com as a tracking method for projects
- Organizing legal files
- Review and shredding of over 26 boxes of legal files from Margaret
- Supporting the prosecutor and having the Legal Assistant provide administrative support (motions, discovery, trial preparation)






### Contracts & Agreements

- Currently collaborating on the execution of at least 56 contracts and/or agreements that are expected to execute by year end 2022.


