

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE CONTRACT AMENDMENT FOR PHASE II – OF PROJECT #21-006682 DESIGN SERVICES FOR CITY OF BRIGHTON MUNICIPAL SERVICE CENTER TO THE CONTRACT OF D2C ARCHITECTS AND APPROVING THE CONTRACT AMENDMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF NINE HUNDRED THIRTY SIX THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE DOLLARS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE TO SIGN THE CONTRACT AMENDMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, on or about March 23, 2021, the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City”), and D2C Architects (“D2C”) entered into that certain contract (the “Contract”) for the PHASE I DESIGN SERVICES (“Phase I”) FOR CITY OF BRIGHTON MUNICIPAL SERVICE CENTER, PROJECT #21-006682 (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, funding was approved in the 2022 budget for the Project; and

WHEREAS, D2C submitted pricing for Phase II – Design Services for the City of Brighton Municipal Service Center, Project #21-006682 (“Phase II”) which has been reviewed by the City and aligns with the current needs: and

WHEREAS, the original contract amount for Phase I was \$451,847.00; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to alter the scope of the Contract by adding Phase II resulting in an additional amount of \$936,385.00 (the “Contract Amendment”); and

WHEREAS, the total Contract amount comes to \$1,388,232.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Contract Amendment is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the City.

Section 3. That all other provisions of the Contract not modified or amended herein by this amendment are hereby ratified in their entirety and remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Resolution is effective upon the date of its adoption.
