

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-138

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER AND THE CITY OF BRIGHTON REGARDING URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE GRANT FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton (“City”), has identified a strategic focus on supporting a Safe, Active and Engaged Community; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the City and County of Denver (“Denver”) for the purpose of providing for the distribution of Urban Area Security Initiative (“UASI”) grant funds if said funds are awarded; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to collaborate to address capability gaps in planning, organizing, equipping, training, and exercising activities to further the purposes of the UASI program; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to: participate in UASI regional planning and interagency coordination activities, including, but not limited to, the Threat Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA)/ Stakeholder Preparedness Review (SPR) process and Training and Exercise Planning Workshops (TEPW); and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to comply with the terms of all current and future UASI grant provisions; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to make UASI trained personnel and equipment available for regional training, exercise and response activities, as reasonably available; and

WHEREAS, City Council believes this continued partnership and access to UASI funding opportunities to be in the best interest of the citizens of Brighton in support of public safety activities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Intergovernmental Agreement between Denver and the City providing for the distribution of UASI grant funds is hereby approved.
2. The City Manager and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and deliver such agreement on behalf of the City in substantially the form presented at this meeting with such technical additions, deletions and variations as the City Attorney may deem necessary or appropriate and not inconsistent with this Resolution.
