## Current Lodging Tax Grant Structure

- 2018 Pilot Program
  - 40% Economic Development Corporation
  - 40% Brighton Cultural Arts Commission
  - 20% other applications
- Results
  - Substantial pass through to Armory and Brighton Chamber
  - Few “other” applications



## Proposed Lodging Tax Grant Structure

- “Other applications” funded off the top
- 30% Economic Development Corporation
- 30% Brighton Cultural Arts Commission
- 20% Brighton Chamber of Commerce
- 20% Armory
