- Project was formally bid and only 1 bid from Musco Sports Lighting, LLC was received on November 27, 2019




- Musco Sports Lighting, LLC met all of the formal bid requirements
- Musco is part of the national bidding cooperative entitled Sourcewell Cooperative
 - City's Procurement utilizes Sourcewell for other City projects
- Musco is:
 - In good standing with the State of Colorado
 - The most responsive and responsible bid
 - Within the budgeted amount for the project and can complete the installations in 2020

Project Details (continued)

- Project amount is \$207,800.00 was approved in City's 2020 Annual Budget – Recreation Capital
 - The 2019 grant funding from 2 Adams County Open Space Grants (Ken Mitchell Park and Colorado Park) was carried over to 2020 Budget
- Lighting is LED, dark sky technology, has satellite link controls, and has a 25 year warranty that covers materials and onsite labor
- Project consists of lighting installation of:
 - New basketball courts at Ken Mitchell Park and Donelson Park
 - Tennis courts, basketball court, and parking lot lighting at Colorado Park







BID AWARD REQUEST

The most responsive and responsible bid to perform the required services is Musco Sports Lighting, LLC, and they are part of the national bidding cooperative entitled Sourcewell Cooperative.

Staff recommends to City Council the awarding of a contract for the Park Lighting Improvements Project to Musco Sports Lighting, LLC in the amount of \$207,800.00.
