

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-80

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING HOMELESSNESS SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 29-1-203 *et seq.*, and § 29-20-105 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, governmental entities are authorized and encouraged to cooperate by contracting with one another to share in the costs of services or functions for their mutual benefit; and

WHEREAS, Adams County, Commerce City, Federal Heights, Northglenn, Thornton, Westminster, Bennett, and the City and County of Broomfield, and the City of Brighton seek to coordinate around homelessness to gather data and align evidence-based services by entering into a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”); and

WHEREAS, the parties seek to provide a regionally coordinated, aligned, and evidence-based approach to providing services in Adams and Broomfield Counties and will begin by gathering data and identifying programs or grants to leverage funding for services; and

WHEREAS, the MOU does not bind any party to any financial obligation and Adams County will facilitate the work and the City will be responsible for participating in meetings and sharing data; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes this action to be in the best interest of the citizens of Brighton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado, as follows:

1. The *Memorandum of Understanding* (“MOU”), is hereby approved and the Mayor is authorized to execute said MOU on behalf of the City.
2. This Resolution is effective upon the date of its adoption.
