

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO ADOPTING THE 2015 CULTURAL STRATEGIC PLAN AS THE GOVERNING DOCUMENT FOR THE FUTURE OF ARTS AND CULTURE IN THE CITY OF BRIGHTON

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-40

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brighton recognizes the value of our community's diverse arts and culture heritage; and

WHEREAS, the Brighton Cultural Arts Commission, the City of Brighton's Office of Arts and Culture, and many departments and volunteers have worked for many years to preserve and promote cultural arts in the community; and

WHEREAS, it is important for the community to have a long-range plan for developing and sustaining cultural arts in the community; and

WHEREAS, the creation of the 2015 Cultural Strategic Plan sets forth the process for implementing, sustaining, and growing cultural arts in Brighton; and

WHEREAS, upon its adoption, the Cultural Strategic Plan and process will provide guidance to City Council, city staff, cultural non-profit organizations, and volunteers in the Brighton cultural influence area on matters concerning cultural arts; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Strategic Plan will incorporate all relevant plans and documents including but not limited to: strategies considered for implementation, implementation plans, implementation schedules, strategy categorizations, the public art plan, surveys and results, mission statements and plans of Brighton Cultural Influence Area non profits and all relevant documents; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Cultural Strategic Plan confirms City Council's commitment to a thriving cultural arts community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The 2015 Cultural Strategic Plan and process, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby adopted by the City of Brighton.
2. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to undertake such tasks as may be required to implement said Plan on behalf of the City.
