

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-69

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, CONFIRMING THE CITY OF BRIGHTON'S PARTICIPATION IN THE LINK PROGRAM IN CALENDAR YEAR 2022; APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION AND FUNDING OF JUVENILE ASSESSMENT SERVICES BY THE LINK; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE IGA ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 29-1-203 *et seq.*, and § 29-20-105 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, governmental entities are authorized and encouraged to cooperate by contracting with one another to share in the costs of services or functions for their mutual benefit; and

WHEREAS, The Link has operated and served Adams County and the cities located within Adams County since October of 1999 and provides assessment, mediation, and intervention services for juveniles and their families who are referred from participating jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton wishes to continue as a participating jurisdiction for fiscal year 2022 and confirms the 2022 Annual Assessment for the City of Brighton of \$ 72,988 which is included in the 2022 Adopted Budget and based on the cost of the City's pro rata share of the current six-year average of historical juvenile transports as compared to the total for all participating jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the participating jurisdictions have prepared and agreed to an *Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision and Funding of Juvenile Assessment Services by the Link*, which IGA sets forth the scope of the Link program as well as the formula for determining the financial assessments for each participating jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes this action to be in the best interest of the citizens of Brighton and serves the public purpose of assuring centralized juvenile assessment and referrals, crisis intervention, and services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado, as follows:

1. The *Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision and Funding of Juvenile Assessment Services by the Link*, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby approved and the City Manager is authorized to execute said IGA on behalf of the City.
2. The City of Brighton's continuation as a participating jurisdiction in the Link for 2022 and the annual assessment of \$72,988 for such participation is hereby approved.
3. This Resolution is effective upon the date of its adoption.
