

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AMENDING THE APPOINTMENT FOR THE CITY OF BRIGHTON DISTRICT PLAN COMMISSION MEMBERS FROM FOUR-YEAR TERMS TO THREE-YEAR TERMS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council approved Resolution 2017-04 on January 3, 2017, Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement with Adams County Regarding the Formation of a Joint District Plan Commission (the “IGA”); and establishing the District Plan Commission; and

WHEREAS, the IGA provides that the County shall appoint five (5) members to the District Plan Commission and the City shall appoint four (4) members to the Commission with all members to have three year terms after the initial term; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council approved Resolution Nos. 2019-11, 2019-19, 2020-08, and 2020-14 appointing members to the District Plan Commission for four-year terms; and

WHEREAS, to bring the appointments into compliance with Resolution 2017-04, the Terms of office for the City of Brighton District Plan Commission Members will be amended to reflect the three-year terms.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO THAT THE FOLLOWING CHANGES TO PREVIOUS APPOINTMENTS BE MADE:

Section 1. The appointment for Amanda Griffin to the District Plan Commission is changed from January 2023 to January 2022.

Section 2. The appointment for R. Wayne Walvoord to the District Plan Commission will be changed from January 2023 to January 2022.

Section 3. The appointment for Adam Kniss to the District Plan Commission will be changed from January 2024 to January 2023.

Section 4. The appointment for Wayne Scott to the District Plan Commission will be changed from January 2024 to January 2023.

Section 5. All parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
