A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FUNDS FOR A 2015 SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000) FOR THE CEMETERY CREMATION SPREADING GARDENS AND INTERFUND TRANSFER FROM THE CEMETERY PERPETUAL CARE FUND

WHEREAS, authority is granted by sections 29-1-109 and 29-1-111 of the Colorado Revised Statutes and Section 10.12 of the City of Brighton, Colorado Charter to amend the adopted budget for the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, those adjustments to the 2015 Budget which are necessary for the 2015 City operations could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 2015 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has been advised by the City Manager that the revision to the 2015 Budget as contained within this resolution can adequately be implemented as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado that:

The Cemetery Perpetual Care Fund be increased from \$0 to \$150,000 in the following accounts:
