

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ADOPTING INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY POLICIES TO DEFINE GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS REGARDING THE USE OF COMPUTER RESOURCES AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGIES BY CITY OF BRIGHTON USERS.

WHEREAS, the Information Technology Department has updated, for Council’s consideration, proposed policies regarding use of technology by City of Brighton users; and

WHEREAS, the IT policies are an integral part of information technology and applies to all City of Brighton “users.” The term “users” apply to any person in the City of Brighton, third party contractors, guests, temporaries, licensees, as well as those who represent themselves as being connected – in one way or another – to the City of Brighton who uses, possesses or has access to City of Brighton communications systems; and

WHEREAS, IT policies have been written for acceptable use of information resources, passwords, network security, internet and email; and

WHEREAS, the IT policies, which must be read and acknowledged by every user, provide guidelines for all users of the City of Brighton to follow.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Brighton City Council adopts version 5 of the Information Technology policies.
