

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS WATER ACTIVITY ENTERPRISE, ACCEPTING THE BID OF EXCAVATION & CONSTRUCTION SPECIALIST, INC., AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE INDIGO TRAILS WATERLINE TO EXCAVATION AND CONSTRUCTION SPECIALIST, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$189,676.00), AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS FOR UNFORESEEN SITE CONDITIONS UP TO FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, *“The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies”*; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.08 of the Brighton Municipal Code, Sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing of supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services; and

WHEREAS, the City published a notice inviting bids through its formal solicitation process for completion of the Indigo Trails Waterline, (ITB#17-055); and

WHEREAS, funding was approved in the 2017 budget; and

WHEREAS, Excavation & Construction Specialist, INC. submitted a bid for the project which has been reviewed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that Excavation & Construction Specialist, INC. is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Indigo Trails Waterline; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that it is in the best interest of the City to accept the bid of Excavation & Construction Specialist, INC., in the amount of One Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars (\$189,676.00), to award the contract for the Indigo Trails Waterline to Excavation & Construction Specialist, INC., in an amount not to exceed of One Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars (\$189,676.00), and to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract on behalf of the City and the City Clerk to Attest thereto; and

WHEREAS, Council believes it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager to approve changes in the contract amount up to Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) in order to facilitate efficient and responsible project management should unforeseen circumstances arise.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS WATER ENTERPRISE, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Excavation & Construction Specialist, INC. is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Indigo Trails Waterline and
2. That the bid of Excavation & Construction Specialist, INC. in the amount of One Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars (\$189,676.00), is hereby approved; and
3. That funding was approved in the 2017 Budget; and
4. That the Contract for the Indigo Trails Waterline is hereby awarded to Excavation & Construction Specialist, INC. in the amount of One Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars (\$189,676.00); and
5. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the contract with Excavation & Construction Specialist, INC., on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk to Attest thereto.
6. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to approve changes to the contract amount up to Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00).
