## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-48

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITIES OF AURORA, BRIGHTON, COMMERCE CITY, FEDERAL HEIGHTS, NORTHGLENN, THORNTON, WESTMINSTER AND THE ADAMS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR THE PROVISION OF MUNICIPAL COURT VIDEO SERVICES, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Cities of Aurora, Brighton, Commerce City, Federal Heights, Northglenn, Thornton, and Westminster ("Cities") and the Adams County Sheriff's Office ("Adams County") wish to enter into this Agreement ("IGA") so that the Cities may use the services of Adams County employees for video court services; and

WHEREAS, Adams County employs a number of personnel who are qualified and able to assist the Cities with the performance of said video court services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties are willing to enter into this IGA to provide staffing support for municipal court video proceedings at the Adams County Detention Facility; and

WHEREAS, Section 18(2)(a) of Article XIV of the Colorado Constitution and Sections 29-1-201, et seq., and 29-20-105 of the Colorado Revised Statutes authorize and encourage local governmental entities to cooperate by contracting with one another for their mutual benefit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO:

- Section 1. The IGA between the Cities and Adams County is hereby approved.
- Section 2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and deliver such Agreement on behalf of the City in substantially the form presented at this meeting, with such technical additions, deletions, and variations as the City Attorney may deem necessary or appropriate and not inconsistent with this Resolution.
- <u>Section 3</u>. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
