



- ▶ The City has a Park Naming policy that was adopted by the City Council.
 - ▶ The Policy includes submitting a petition with the reason for the proposed name and 25 signatures of Brighton Residents.
 - ▶ The City Clerk has received a Petition for the naming of the Neighborhood Park in the Southgate Subdivision.
 - ▶ The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board reviewed the Naming Petition and determined that it meets the Park Naming Criteria.
 - ▶ On March 7, 2018 the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board held a public meeting to solicit input on the proposed name.
 - ▶ Michelle Grajeda, a member of the Foley family was in attendance to present the naming petition.
 - ▶ At the March 7, 2018 Meeting of the PRAB they recommended to the City Council the name for the Neighborhood Park in the Southgate Subdivision be

“ORAN AND ROSA FOLEY PARK”
