

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF IDEAL FENCING CORPORATION, LLC FOR THE WATER TOWER FENCING PROJECT FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$135,850.00), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (the “City”) desires to convert the natural grass at Water Tower Park to artificial turf, which will require a perimeter fence to prevent damage to the artificial turf investment; and

WHEREAS, the City, published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for the Water Tower Improvement – Fencing, Project #23-001f (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Ideal Fencing Corporation, LLC (“Ideal”), submitted a bid for the Project in the amount of \$135,850.00 (the “Proposal”); and

WHEREAS, the City believes that Ideal is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “[t]he Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies”; and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Proposal of Ideal is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to sign the contract for the Project with Ideal on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
