

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-49

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF TAYLOR KOHRS LLC AND APPROVING THE PROCUREMENT OF THE BENEDICT PARK RENOVATION CONSTRUCTION FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED NINETEEN DOLLARS (\$2,847,319), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton ("City"), desires to renovate the existing 21.83-acre Benedict Park by expanding the existing skatepark; installing new shelters, lighting, and irrigation system; and adding two new playgrounds, supplemental landscaping, and a walking trail on the east end of the park; and

WHEREAS, the City published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for the Benedict Park Renovation Construction, Project #24-008513 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriations exists for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Taylor Kohrs LLC ("TK") submitted a bid for the Project in the amount of \$2,847,319 (the "Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes TK is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Proposal of TK is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney is hereby authorized to sign the contract for the Project with TK on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
