

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-36

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, RE-APPOINTING ONE "ON CALL" DEPUTY MUNICIPAL JUDGE AND APPOINTING ONE "ON CALL" JUDGE TO SERVE ON AN "AS NEEDED" BASIS; SETTING THEIR TERM OF OFFICE AND COMPENSATION; AND SETTING FORTH OTHER DETAILS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8.2(B) and (D) of the City of Brighton Charter, the City Council is charged with the responsibility of appointing by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members in office, such Deputy Municipal Judges as the Council deems necessary and for setting the compensation of the Deputy Municipal Judges; and

WHEREAS, Section 8.2(C) of the Charter states that each "on call" Deputy Municipal Judge shall be an attorney at law admitted to practice in Colorado and have at least five (5) years of experience in the active practice of law. The Brighton City Council also requires that the "on call" Deputy Municipal Judges also have judicial experience; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited applications for qualified candidates to be considered for the "on call" Deputy Municipal Judge positions; applications were received and reviewed by a City committee consisting of Presiding Judge Michelle Kline, Court Administrator Michelle Ramos, and Assistant City Manager Karen Borkowski Surine (the "Committee"); and

WHEREAS, Charles Peters was appointed as an "on-call" Deputy Municipal Judge on April 7, 2020 via Resolution 2020-35, has provided such services as requested, and the committee recommends re-appointment; and

WHEREAS, after careful review and consideration of the candidates' qualifications, the Committee recommends that one additional candidate, Johnny Barajas, be appointed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary to appoint the "on call" Deputy Municipal Judges and set their terms of office and compensation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado, as follows:

1. Charles Peters is hereby re-appointed as Deputy Municipal Judge, to serve on an "as needed" basis or "on-call" as determined by the Presiding Municipal Judge. Nothing in this appointment shall make the Deputy Municipal Judge an employee of the City of Brighton, and he shall be an independent contractor throughout his term.
2. Johnny Barajas is hereby appointed as Deputy Municipal Judge, to serve on an "as needed" or "on-call" basis as determined by the Presiding Municipal Judge. Nothing in this appointment shall make the Deputy Municipal Judge an employee of the City of Brighton, and he shall be an independent contractor throughout his term.

3. The term for each Deputy Municipal Judge shall be two-years, as of the effective date of this Resolution.
4. That each Deputy Municipal Judge shall be compensated when needed at the rate of \$80.00/hour, and not be eligible for any other City benefits.
5. This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of its adoption.
