

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-68

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH ARROW-J LANDSCAPE AND DESIGN, INC. FOR THE CHANGE ORDER AMOUNT OF FORTY-SIX THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$46,155.00)

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City”), previously awarded a contract (“Contract”) to Arrow-J Landscape and Design, Inc. (“Arrow-J”) for the construction landscaping of Founder’s Plaza, Project No. 22-0077250 (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the City Council expressed a desire to fabricate and install a safety railing at Founder’s Plaza along the existing north planter bed adjacent to Bridge Street to deter individuals from climbing on the wall (the “Safety Railing”); and

WHEREAS, the Safety Railing was not included in the original scope of work for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Arrow-J Landscape and Design, Inc. (“Arrow-J”) submitted a change order for the Safety Railing in the amount of \$46,155.00 (the “Change Order”); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project and the Change Order; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3-8-17 of the Brighton Municipal Code, “[a]ll change orders greater than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) or change orders in aggregate greater than twenty-five percent (25%) of the original contract amount shall be approved by the City Council.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Change Order of Arrow-J is hereby approved.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute the Change Order on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective upon the date of its adoption.
