WHEREAS, on July 1, 2009, the Mayor and City Council approved Ordinance 2002 amending the policies for appointment of members to City boards, commissions, and authorities, and to specify term limits for certain board, commission, and authority appointees; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2010, the Mayor and City Council approved Ordinance 2081 amending Section 2-66-10, "Establishment; Membership," of the Brighton Municipal Code by adding two alternate positions to the Historic Preservation Commission; and

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2018, the Mayor and City Council approved Resolution No. 2018-39 amending the policy regarding the interview and appointment procedures for City boards, commissions, and authorities, in order to delegate the interview responsibility to members of certain designated boards, commissions, and authorities; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with Resolution No. 2018-39, the Historic Preservation Commission conducted interviews for the open positions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the Historic Preservation Commission that it have interested and qualified members in order for it to function and work toward the betterment of the City.
