A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO,  
CREATING A COMMITTEE TO REVIEW THE CHARTER AND MAKE  
RECOMMENDATIONS FOR POSSIBLE AMENDMENTS TO THE CHARTER

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton (“City”) is a home rule municipality and adopted its Charter on July 7, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received feedback and comments from residents about possible changes that could be made to the Charter and would like to review the Charter to identify possible recommendations for action; and

WHEREAS, the City Council discussed the Charter formation and amendment process on January 17, 2023, and asked to be brought a resolution to consider the formation of a working committee to review the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to appoint two City Council members and no more than three residents to form a Charter Review Committee, which shall be selected after receiving letters of interest from residents and conducting interviews if more than three such letters of interest are received; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds a working committee is needed to review the Charter and consider possible amendments to be brought back before the entire council for consideration and possible referral to the voters for action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby creates a Charter Review Committee with the following members: two City Council members, three residents of the City of Brighton, and the City Manager as a non-voting member.

Section 2. The City Council will accept letters of interest to be submitted to the City Clerk for the next thirty (30) days from residents interested in participating in the Charter Review Committee, such letters to be accepted no later than May 4th, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.

Section 3. The Charter Review Committee shall bring back its recommendations to the entire City Council within ninety (90) days or less from its first meeting and shall cease to exist upon action taken by City Council on the recommendations, but no later than September 30, 2023.

Section 4. This Resolution is effective upon the date of its adoption.
