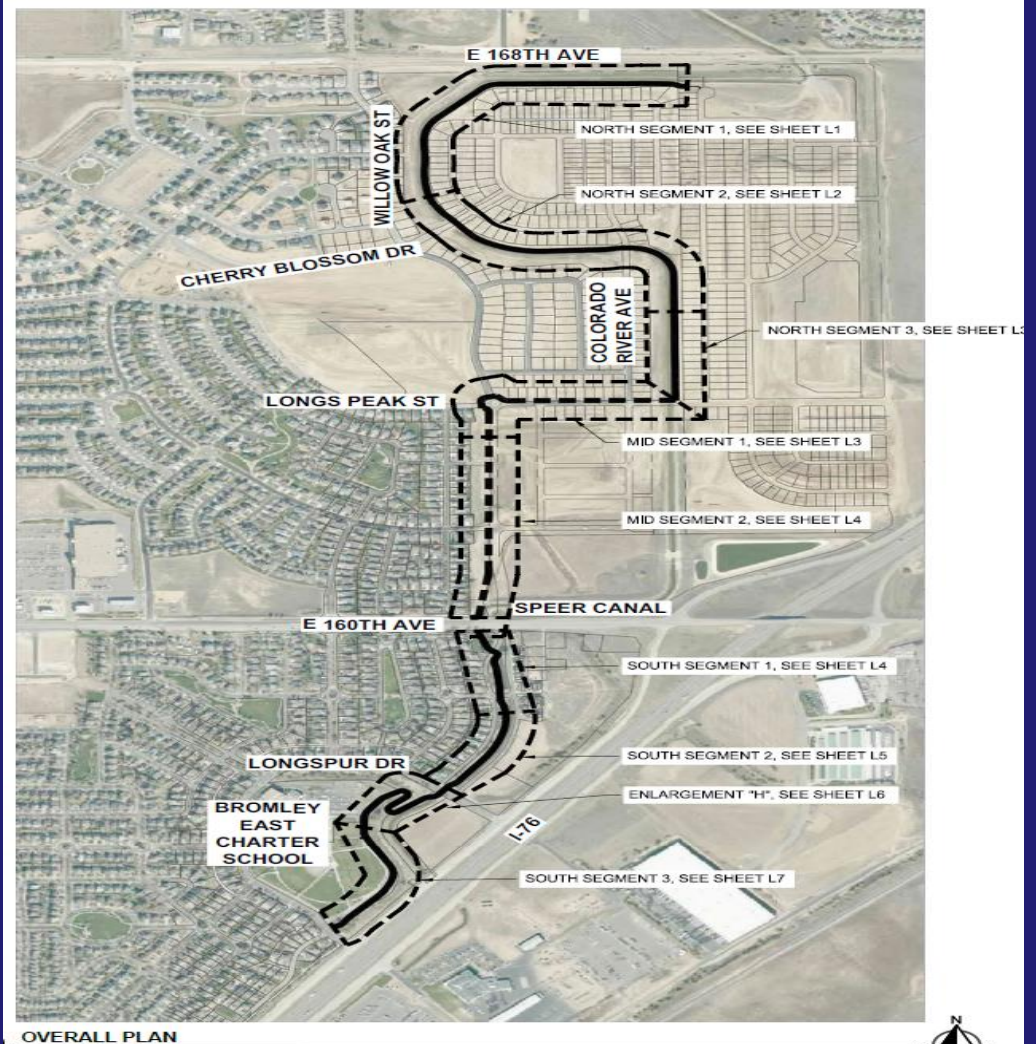

Speer Canal Trail

Background

- Located: Northeast section of Brighton
- It would span from E 168th Avenue to Bromley East Charter School
- 2/3rds of this trail would be built by the City
- 1st section would be from ~E 168th Avenue to Longs Peak Street
- 2nd section would be from Bridge Street to Bromley East Charter School



Speer Canal Trail

Background Continued

- North Section – 4,945.41 linear feet or 0.94 miles
 - Middle Section (Developer) – 3,161.24 linear feet or 0.60 miles
 - South Section – 2,162.39 linear feet or 0.41 miles
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- Total length of trail construction
 - 10,269.04 linear feet
 - 1.94 miles



Speer Canal Trail

New Trail Features

- 10 feet wide, 6 inches thick
- All concrete
- ADA ramps at crossings
- Signage
- Major North South connection on the east side of Brighton

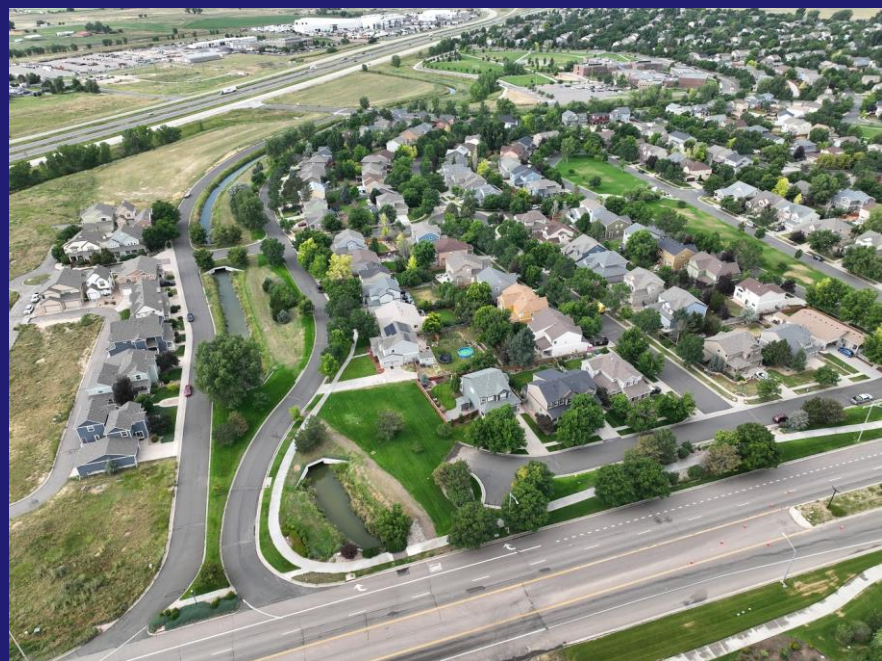

- Sufficient appropriation exists for this project with a total project cost for installation of the concrete trail for \$628,440.00
- Funding Source: Parks and Recreation Capital/Lottery Projects
