WHEREAS, the City of Brighton has been dedicated to supporting these young marketers and celebrating their success over these fifty years; and

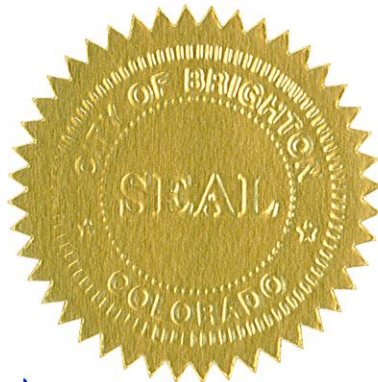
