A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ADAMS COUNTY, COLORADO LEGAL SERVICES, THE CITIES OF WESTMINSTER, THORNTON, FEDERAL HEIGHTS, BRIGHTON, COMMERCE CITY, AURORA, NORTHGLENN, AND THE CITY AND COUNTY OF BROOMFIELD REGARDING CONTRIBUTIONS TOWARD A LANDLORD/TENANT LEGAL SERVICES PROGRAM, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID IGA ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AND TO UNDERTAKE SUCH TASKS AND EXECUTE SUCH DOCUMENTS AS MAY BE REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT SAID IGA ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Adams County, the cities of Westminster, Thornton, Federal Heights, Commerce City, Aurora, Northglenn, and the City and County of Broomfield (the "Contributing Members") and Colorado Legal Services ("CLS") desire to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") to address the cost associated with the Landlord/Tenant Legal Services Program ("Program"); and

WHEREAS, City Council find and determines that the terms of the IGA are reasonable, that this IGA exemplifies the spirit of cooperation between CLS and the Contributing Members, and that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Brighton that the IGA be approved; and

WHEREAS, Section 18(2)(a) of Article XIV of the Colorado Constitution and Sections 29-1-201, *et seq.*, and 29-20-105 of the Colorado Revised Statutes authorize and encourage local governmental entities to cooperate by contracting with one another for their mutual benefit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The IGA between Adams County, Colorado Legal Services, the Cities of Westminster, Thornton, federal Heights, Brighton, Commerce City, Aurora, Northglenn, and the City and County of Broomfield is hereby approved.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Manager is authorized to execute said IGA on behalf of the City and to undertake such tasks and execute such documents as may be required to implement said IGA on behalf of the City.

<u>Section 3.</u> All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
