

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE PLACEMENT OF A PLAQUE ON MEMORIAL PARKWAY RECOGNIZING SAMUEL ALBIN MAR WAGNER FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE BRIGHTON COMMUNITY.

Resolution No. 2015-90

WHEREAS, heretofore, the City Council of the City of Brighton adopted Resolution No. 03-14, establishing a Policy for the naming of public amenities and park and recreation facilities in the City of Brighton, including the procedure for selecting Names for recognition on the Memorial Parkway (the “Naming Policy”); and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received one Petition, submitted pursuant to and in accordance with the Naming Policy, requesting recognition of Samuel Albin Mar Wagner for his service to the Brighton Community; and

WHEREAS, Samuel Albin Mar Wagner was a Brighton Native who willingly and enthusiastically shared his knowledge of Brighton History and served the Brighton Community as Historian, Journalist, Author, Educator and Artist. He was an editor of the Standard Blade/Manager-Editor of Fort Lupton Press, and wrote several books on the history of Brighton and Adams County. He served on the Brighton Historical Commissions and as Adams County Historian; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board has reviewed the Petition, and has found and determined that the Petition properly meets all of the relevant criteria established by the Naming Policy; and

WHEREAS, The Park and Recreation Advisory Board at their meeting of August 5, 2015 recommended that Samuel Albin Mar Wagner be recognized for his service to the Brighton Community by placing a plaque on the Memorial Parkway; and

WHEREAS, The City Council finds and determines that The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, at their meeting of August 5, 2015, did unanimously approve the motion recommending to the City Council, the Advisory’s Board’s support for the Petition, and the placement of a plaque on the Memorial Parkway recognizing Samuel Albin Mar Wagner for his service to the Brighton Community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, that:

1. A plaque be placed o the Memorial Parkway recognizing Samuel Albin Mar Wagner for his service to the Brighton Community.
