

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON,
COLORADO, ELIMINATING ALTERNATE COMMISSIONERS TO THE BRIGHTON
URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY BY RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 09-22**

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-96

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2001, the Brighton City Council (City Council) adopted Resolution No. 01-58 establishing and creating the Brighton Urban Renewal Authority (BURA); and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2002, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 01-70, amending Section 4 of Resolution No. 01-58 by establishing the BURA Commission, setting the number of Commissioners and the method for appointment, and setting forth other details related thereto; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2008, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 08-26, increasing the number of Commissioners from seven to nine; and

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2009, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 09-22 amending various sections and paragraphs of Resolution 01-58, as amended by Resolution 01-70, and Resolution No. 08-26, to provide for Alternate Commissioners to the BURA; and

WHEREAS, to be consistent with provisions of Colorado Urban Renewal Law, C.R.S. §31-25-101 et seq., and in anticipation of future required changes to the structure and composition of the BURA Commission pursuant to Colorado House Bill 15-1348 (the Urban Redevelopment Fairness Act), the City Council finds and determines it to be in the best interest of the City of Brighton to eliminate the two Alternate Commissioner positions to the BURA Commission by rescinding Resolution 09-22, and to restore various sections and paragraphs of Resolution 01-58, as amended by Resolution 01-70, and Resolution No. 08-26, to pre-Resolution No. 09-22 status.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado, as follows:

1. Resolution No. 09-22, as adopted on February 3, 2009 is hereby rescinded.
2. Section 4 of Resolution No. 01-58, as amended by 01-70 (Sections A., C., D., and E.) and Resolution No. 08-26, paragraphs 1, 2, 3, and 4 are hereby restored to read as they did prior to adoption of Resolution No. 09-22.
