

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF MERIDIAM PARTNERS, LLC FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTEEN DOLLARS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City”), published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process to drain, dredge, and reline the north pond at the Brighton Recreation Center, Project No. 21-007254 (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Meridiam Partners, LLC, a Colorado limited liability company (“Meridiam”) submitted a bid for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that Meridiam is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies;” and

WHEREAS, Section 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The proposal of Meridiam Partners, LLC is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute the contract with Meridiam for the Project on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective upon the date of its adoption.
