

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-64

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AMENDING THE 2022 FEE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, authority is granted by the State of Colorado to the governing body of the City of Brighton, Colorado to assess fees and charges for services provided by the City (Colorado Constitution Article XX, Section 6); and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton has adopted a municipal code which allows for the setting and collection of fees; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2021, the City Council approved the 2022 Fee Resolution, Resolution No. 2021-83 (the “2022 Fee Resolution”); and

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly passed, and on April 21, 2022, the Governor enacted Senate Bill 22-032 (the “Act”), which prohibits a local taxing jurisdiction from charging a fee for a local general business license (the “Business and Sales Tax License Fee”) to a retailer that has a state standard retail license, makes retail sales within the local taxing jurisdiction, and either does not have physical presence within the local taxing jurisdiction or has only incidental physical presence within the local taxing jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has been advised by the City Manager that, in accordance with the Act, the City should eliminate the Business and Sales Tax License Fee for “all other businesses.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As provided below, the Business and Sales Tax License Fee for “all other businesses,” as set forth in the 2022 Fee Resolution at Attachment 7, Section 1, is hereby eliminated:
