A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF FCI CONSTRUCTORS, INC. FOR THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE CENTER PHASE 2 FOR THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-SIX MILLION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FOURTEEN DOLLARS (\$26,151,414.00) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AMENDMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado ("City"), desires to construct a new Municipal Service Center that would accommodate Streets Maintenance, Fleet Maintenance, Parks Maintenance, and Utility Maintenance, all of which currently operate in separate facilities and locations; and

WHEREAS, the City published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for the Municipal Service Center, Project #21-007046 ("Project") and awarded Phase 1 to FCI Constructors, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter and Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code, the City previously awarded Phase 1 to FCI Constructors, Inc. ("FCI") for preconstruction services for the Project in the amount of \$34,500.00 by Resolution No. 2022-09; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to accept the Proposal for the next phase of the Project, which includes construction ("Phase 2"); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for Phase 2 of the Project; and

WHEREAS, FCI submitted a proposal for the Guaranteed Maximum Price for Phase 2 of the Project in the amount of \$26,151,414 (the "Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the City believes that the Proposal from FCI for Phase 2 is reasonable and should be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Proposal of FCI for Phase 2 is hereby accepted.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute the contract amendment with FCI for Phase 2 of the Project in substantially the form presented at this meeting, with such technical additions or revisions as the City Attorney may deem necessary.
 - <u>Section 3</u>. This resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
