

## RESOLUTION

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS WATER ENTERPRISE, APPROVING A BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,100,000) TO REPAIR FLOOD DAMAGE AT KEN MITCHELL LAKES.**

### **RESOLUTION NO.: 2015-110**

**WHEREAS**, significant damages were sustained at the Ken Mitchell Lakes Cell 1 Diversion Structure during the June 2015 flood event, and

**WHEREAS**, the Ken Mitchell Lakes Cell 1 Diversion Structure is the primary structure used to fill Ken Mitchell Cell 1 during free river events and is indispensable in operation of the Water Utility, and

**WHEREAS**, pending additional investigation when water levels recede, the Ken Mitchell Lakes Cell 1 Diversion Structure appears to have been irreparably damaged and must be reconstructed before Spring 2016, and

**WHEREAS**, the budgetary cost estimate for repair and replacement of the structure including engineering, construction, and permitting costs are One Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,100,000).

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS WATER ENTERPRISE, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Reconstruction of the Ken Mitchell Lakes Cell 1 Diversion Structure and associated facilities is paramount to successful operation of the Water Enterprise's raw water supply.
2. A supplemental budget appropriation in the amount of One Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,100,000) is hereby approved for the emergency repair of flood-damaged infrastructure at Ken Mitchell Lakes.
