



## PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, the "Sock It To Em" sock campaign began in Denver in 2011 and has spread to cities throughout the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, socks are the number one clothing need of the homeless, as they wear out faster than any other article of clothing, and are rarely donated; and

**WHEREAS**, the "Sock It To Em" sock campaign kicked off its fourth annual effort to provide warm socks to homeless persons in metro Denver on Thanksgiving Day, November 27, 2014, and will collect donated socks through December 31, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the "Sock It To Em" sock campaign has designated December 10, 2014 as "Sock It To Em Workday", a day when our residents are asked to forego wearing their socks as a show of support for the homeless, and to recognize the great need of homeless persons for warm socks; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brighton fully and strongly supports this effort and encourages our residents to participate by going to work sockless and donating socks for the homeless.

**NOW THEREFORE I**, Richard N. McLean, Mayor of the City of Brighton, do hereby proclaim December 10, 2014 as:

### *"SOCK IT TO EM WORKDAY"*

in the City of Brighton and encourage all of our residents to doff their socks on December 10, 2014, and donate socks for the homeless from now through December 31, 2014.
