WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado, on April 14, 2006, adopted after final reading, Ordinance No. 1881 which provides for the repealing of Section 2.24 and enacting a new Section 2.24 of the Brighton Municipal Code, entitled City of Brighton Youth Commission; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1881 established Membership Requirements, Terms of Office, and Organizational Procedures for the Youth Commission; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2070 adopted September 7, 2010 amends Section 2-25-40 of the Brighton Municipal Code changes age requirements for membership, provides for alternates and clarifies the Commission representatives from School District 27J; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to enable the Youth Commission to function and work toward the betterment of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council embraces the inclusiveness of the selection process as facilitated by the interview team; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs with the selection process and ratifies the recommendation of the Mayor that the following candidates be appointed to the Youth Commission.
