A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, FINDING GOOD CAUSE TO WAIVE THE FORMAL BID PROCESS FOR LAND ACQUISITION SERVICE FOR AG PRESERVATION, BY APPROVING A CONTRACT AMENDMENT FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE PREVIOUSLY AWARDED MULTI-TERM CONTRACT 16M-004, WITH THE CONSERVATION FUND, FOR AN ADDITIONAL ONE YEAR TERM IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE (5) % OF THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE PROPERTY TO BE ACQUIRED AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AND SIGN THE AMENDMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST HERETO

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies; and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-8-120 of the Brighton Municipal Code provides, in pertinent part, that “For good cause shown, the City Council may waive the formal bid procedure for contracts greater than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000). However, any such waiver shall be implemented only if there is first a determination by the City Council that such waiver will be in the best interest of the City”; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.08 of the Brighton Municipal Code, sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing of supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that it is in the best interest to extend Contract 16M-004 for an additional one (1) year term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The waiver of bid for Land Acquisition Service for AG Preservation is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or Designee, is hereby authorized to sign the amendment on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk to attest thereto.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
