

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE NAMING OF THE CIRCLE DRIVE IN ELMWOOD CEMETERY, 14800 OLD BRIGHTON ROAD, BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS “NEAL NAHLER WAY”.

WHEREAS, heretofore, the City Council of the City of Brighton adopted Resolution No. 03-14, establishing a Policy for the naming of public amenities and park and recreation facilities in the City of Brighton, including open space parcels in Brighton (the “Naming Policy”); and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received one Petition, submitted pursuant to and in accordance with the Naming Policy, requesting the name of “Neal Nahler Way” for that certain Circle Drive located in Elmwood Cemetery, 14800 Old Brighton Road, Brighton, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board has reviewed the Petition, and has found and determined that the Petition properly meets all of the relevant criteria established by the Naming Policy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, at their meeting of March 4, 2015, did unanimously approve the motion recommending to the City Council, the Advisory’s Board’s support for the Petition, and the naming of the Circle Drive in Elmwood Cemetery as “**Neal Nahler Way**”, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, that:

1. The Circle Drive located in Elmwood Cemetery, 14800 Old Brighton Road, Brighton, Colorado, shall be named and hereafter known as: “**NEAL NAHLER WAY**”; and
2. The City of Brighton will install a sign at the Circle Drive evidencing the name of “**Neal Nahler Way**”.
