

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF FEHR & PEERS, AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE VISION ZERO AND SCHOOL ZONE SAFETY ACTION PLAN, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$106,680.00) TO FEHR & PEERS; AUTHORIZING A 2018 GENERAL FUND BUDGET AMENDMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$106,680.00); AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST THERETO.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “*The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies*”; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 3.08 of the Brighton Municipal Code, sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing of supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City published a notice inviting proposals through its formal solicitation process for Vision Zero and School Zone Safety Action Plan, (RFP #17-063); and

**WHEREAS**, Fehr & Peers, submitted a proposal for the project which has been reviewed by the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City believes that Fehr & Peers, is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Vision Zero and School Zone Safety Action Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, a 2018 budget amendment authorizing the expenditure in the amount of One Hundred Six Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$106,680.00) is necessary to proceed with the Contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the City believes that it is in the best interests of the City to accept the proposal of Fehr & Peers, in the amount of One Hundred Six Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$106,680.00), to award the contract for the Vision Zero and School Zone Safety Action Plan to Fehr & Peers, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Six Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$106,680.00), and to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract on behalf of the City and the City Clerk to Attest thereto.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Fehr & Peers, is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Vision Zero and School Zone Safety Action Plan; and
2. That the proposal of Fehr & Peers, in the amount of One Hundred Six Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$106,680.00), is hereby approved; and

3. That the 2018 Budget is hereby amended and appropriated for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2018, as follows:

General Fund

Revenues:

Fund Balance \$106,680.00

Expenditures:

Streets- Professional Services \$106,680.00

4. That the Contract for the Vision Zero and School Zone Safety Action Plan is hereby awarded to Fehr & Peers, in the amount not to exceed One Hundred Six Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$106,680.00); and
5. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the contract with Fehr & Peers, on behalf of the City and the City Clerk to Attest thereto.
