Intergovernmental Agreement Overview


- IGA for planning, design, maintenance and construction related to the Brighton South Outfall
- IGA Between the City and Mile High Flood District
- IGA approved by City Council and executed on May 21, 2023



Intergovernmental Agreement Overview

Work in progress:

- South Outfall Master Plan- On-going hydrologic and hydraulic study of the drainage basin tributary to the South Outfall
- Survey of South Outfall to determine maintenance needs related to sediment deposition

Intergovernmental Agreement Overview

Work in progress:

- Muck excavation and removal west of Sable Blvd.
- Muck/sediment removal east of Chambers will begin shortly
- Permanent solution to sedimentation issues
- South Outfall corridor planning



South Outfall Muck Excavation- Just south of Sable Blvd.



Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment Overview

- Additional funding to continue progress on South Outfall planning, design, maintenance and construction projects
- City to contribute \$185,000
- MHFD to contribute \$185,000
- Coming soon: IGA Amendment to move funds left over from previous project, Brighton North Outfall- Baseline Alignment, to this agreement



Staff Recommendation

At a future City Council meeting, City staff recommend approval of a resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment between the City and Mile High Flood District
