A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS FOR THE MAIN STREET: OPEN FOR BUSINESS GRANT PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AND EXECUTE THE APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado ("City Council"), has determined that it is appropriate for the City to apply for funding through the Colorado Department of Local Affairs ("DOLA") Main Street: Open for Business Grant for funding related to revitalization and façade improvements in our Downtown; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the Project contributes to the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Brighton, and that this type of funding is needed to promote continuous revitalization in our Downtown area in Brighton; and

WHEREAS, funding as requested for business assistance is an estimated \$500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City via the Brighton Urban Renewal Authority will allocate an estimated \$100,000.00 in a cash match toward the awards granted through the program; and

WHEREAS, the City finds and determines that it is proper to apply for a \$500,000 Main Street: Open for Business Grant to fund projects related to revitalization and façade improvements in our Downtown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

City Staff is hereby authorized to submit to DOLA the Application for Main Street: Open for Business Grant for the projects related to Downtown revitalization", and the City Manager is authorized to sign and execute the Application on behalf of the City.
