UTILITIES Brighton

Project Background

- Transmissive acoustic assessments enable wastewater collection system managers to transition from a rotational approach of maintenance to a condition-based approach.
- The rapid assessment of the sewer pipes 6" to 12" will diagnose flow capacity and flow conditions.

UTILITIES Brighton

Project Background Cont.

- Each pipe segment will be given a score from 0 to 10.
 - BLOCKED = 0
 - POOR = 1-3
 - FAIR = 4-6
 - GOOD = 7-10
- Once all data is collected, the data will be uploaded into maps and dashboards to easily display flow condition of all assessed pipes in our collection system.


Project Details

- 701,958 Feet of sewer pipe to be assessed. Includes all 6" to 12" pipe in our collection system.
- 2,950 manholes will be assessed in the system. They will be prioritized based on manhole condition and incorporated into the assessment data.
