

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-57

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AMENDING THE CITY COUNCIL POLICY FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO CITY BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND AUTHORITIES; ADDRESSING SPECIFICALLY INTERVIEWS OF CANDIDATES AND OTHER DETAILS

WHEREAS, §2-8-25 of the Brighton Municipal Code provides that “The City Council shall, by resolution, establish a policy for the appointment of members to City boards, commissions and authorities. Such policy shall address, at a minimum, a process for advertising of vacancies, acceptance of application, interviewing of applicant, appointment of members and ratification of appointments.”; and

WHEREAS, City Council has established such policy, most recently by adopting Resolution No. 2018-39; and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City that City council interview candidates for membership to the Brighton Urban Renewal Authority necessitating that the policy be amended; and

WHEREAS, City Council approved Ordinance 2209 allowing the appointment of a hearing officer to act as the Liquor Licensing Authority and eliminating the need to appoint members to the Liquor Licensing Authority; and

WHEREAS, City Council has considered and decided to adopt a different interview procedure for the Planning Commission and the Brighton Urban Renewal Authority.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to amend and update the *Policy Regarding the Interview and Appointment Procedures for City Board, Commission, and Authority Members*.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The ‘City of Brighton Policy Regarding the Interview and Appointment Procedures for City Board, Commission, and Authority Members’ be amended, a copy of which is attached hereto, and is hereby approved.
2. All resolutions or parts of resolution of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
3. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
