RAISE Grant

Federal grant program through the Department of Transportation that funds construction efforts “of significant local or regional significance”

- Bolster economic activity and competitiveness
- Improve safety of locality or region
- Creation of sustainable infrastructure



Bridge Street Widening

- Proposes to widen Bridge Street 22nd to 42nd Avenue
 - Addition of travel lanes in each direction
 - Wider sidewalks that are e-mobility compatible
 - Transit connections
- Grant would allow additional enhancements not currently budgeted
 - Xeriscaped medians
 - Improved traffic data collection
 - Crosswalk and traffic signal improvements
 - Absorb inflation costs on materials/construction
- Bridge Street Widening becomes Bridge Street “Smart Street” project



Project Cost

RAISE Grant: \$12,000,000

City match: \$4,000,000

Total Cost: \$16,000,000

- Match is already budgeted
