

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-103

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, REAPPOINTING WILMA ROSE AS A CULTURAL ARTS COMMISSION MEMBER OF THE LODGING TAX ADVISORY COMMITTEE WITH A TERM TO DECEMBER, 2022

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council approved Ordinance 2121 on December 20, 2011 Adopting a New Article 3-40, Brighton Lodging Tax of the Brighton Municipal Code including Section 3-40-170 which established the Lodging Tax Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council approved Resolution No. 2018-39 on April 3, 2018, amending the *Policy Regarding the Interview and Appointment Procedures for City Boards, Commissions, and Authorities*, to delegate the interview responsibility to certain members of certain designated Boards, Commissions and Authorities; and
