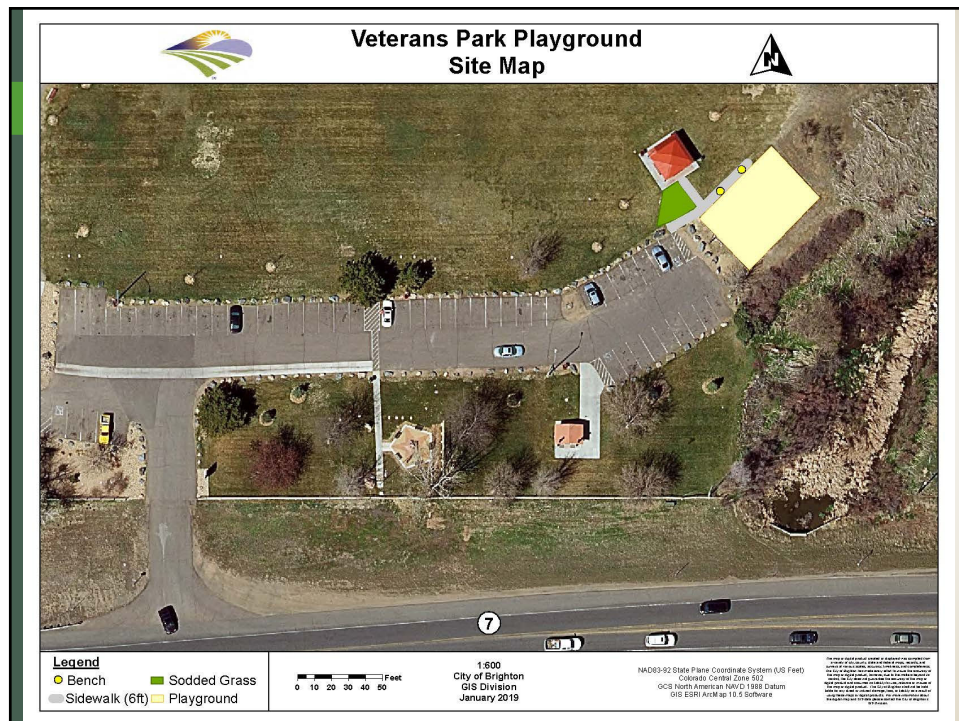




VETERANS PARK PLAYGROUND

Project Details

- Location of Project work – Veterans Park near shade shelter
- Request for Proposals (RFP) occurred in October 2019 – 5 firms submitted and Staff scored the 5 proposals based on criteria listed in RFP
- AtoZ Recreation was the most responsive and responsible submittal
- AtoZ met RFP requirements and had the highest score of 93%
- Per the request of City Council at the November 5, 2019 City Council Meeting – AtoZ Recreation has provided a bid for the same playground equipment and structures with poured-in-place surfacing material
- Project amount is \$185,725.00 and is funded through an Adams County Open Space Grant for \$101,835.00, and will be approved in the City's 2020 Annual Budget – Recreation Capital – Veterans Park line item
- The bid from AtoZ is within the budgeted amount for the project
- This Project consists of demolition and removal of old play structures, installation of an iconic slide structure, 2-bay swing, 2 benches, and new poured-in-place surfacing with patriotic theme
- Construction will occur in 2020







BID AWARD REQUEST

The most responsive and responsible bid to perform the required services is AtoZ Recreation.

Staff recommends to City Council the awarding of a contract for Veterans Park Playground Project to AtoZ Recreation in the amount of \$185,725.00.
