WHEREAS, the City Council accepts the City Attorney's recommendation to re-appoint Mr. Gollin.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Adam Gollin is hereby re-appointed as the Prosecuting Attorney for the Brighton Municipal Court for a two (2)-year term ending December 31, 2021 or as soon as practical thereafter.
- 2. As Prosecuting Attorney, Adam Gollin shall be paid at the hourly rate of \$180.25, on an as needed basis.
- 3. Mr. Gollin shall continue to serve under the direction and supervision of the City Attorney.
