## Proposed Changes to 13-4-180

- Clean-up of Section title
- Removal of unneeded definitions
- Addition of definitions such as "irrigation," "sod installation" and "waste of water"
- Restrict irrigation to three days per week (May 1-Sept. 30)
  - Even Addresses- Irrigation only on Sunday, Tuesday and Friday
  - Odd Addresses- Irrigation only on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday
  - No assigned address (tracts)- Irrigation only on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday
- Irrigation is prohibited between 10am and 6pm

## Proposed Changes to 13-4-180

- Sod installation is prohibited (May 1-Sept. 30)
- Waste of water is prohibited (for example, water flowing from landscaped area to gutter)
- Implement requirements for photographic documentation of violations

Enforcement Schedule

| Tap Size | 1st Violation  | 2nd Violation | 3rd Violation | 4th Violation |
|----------|----------------|---------------|---------------|---------------|
| 3/4 - 1" | Written Notice | \$125         | \$250         | Summons       |
| 1.5 - 4" | Written Notice | \$500         | \$1,000       | Summons       |
| Above 4" | Written Notice | \$1,500       | \$3,000       | Summons       |
