NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The twelve holidays for 2024 shall be the following:

Christmas Eve Day	December 24
Christmas Day	December 25

<u>Section 2</u>. This Resolution does not modify or rescind Resolution No. 2021-89, which remains in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
