Proclamation

Honoring Dr. Ron G. Fair and Dr. Rodney D. Fair for their many years of service to Brighton

WHEREAS, Dr. Ron G. Fair was awarded his Doctor of Optometry degree from the Pennsylvania College of Optometry in 1954, and after serving four years in the United States Army, moved his family to Brighton, Colorado in 1959 to begin his optometry practice; and

WHEREAS, establishing a legacy of compassionate and expert eye care for the community and serving his profession as the first Colorado optometrist to serve as President of the American Optometric Association; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Rodney "Rod" Fair, a proud Brighton High School alumnus, was awarded his Doctor of Optometry degree from the Southern California College of Optometry and, in 1983, joined his father in practice, continuing the family's dedication to exceptional service; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Ron Fair faithfully served the residents of Brighton for more than five decades before retiring in 2011 at the age of 80, and will celebrate his 96th birthday in January 2026; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Rod Fair has carried forward the Fair family's tradition of excellence in eye care and community commitment and will retire in April 2026 at the age of 70; and

WHEREAS, with Dr. Rod Fair's retirement, Brighton will experience—for the first time in 67 years—a moment without a Dr. Fair providing eye care to its residents; and


