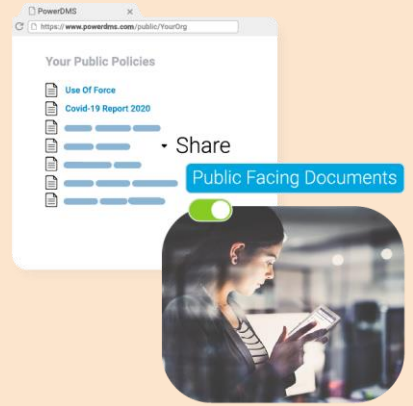

- Offered through the Department of Justice Bureau of Justice Assistance

The Office of Justice Programs is committed to advancing work that promotes civil rights and racial equity, increases access to justice, supports crime victims and individuals impacted by the justice system, strengthens community safety and protects the public from crime and evolving threats, and builds trust between law enforcement and the community.



Awarded \$15,570 for purchase of PowerDMS software

Focused on policy and procedure development, training and public-facing documents for policies on our website.

This program assists with building community trust through policy transparency and a holistic approach to training documentation.



PowerDMS



Power Policy – Develop, review, approve, distribute and track policy. Helps build a culture of compliance through communication of critical updates and access to policies from any device

Power FTO – Manages, tracks and measures on-the-job training for officers. Saves time and resources through program templates and real-time dashboards.

Lexipol Supplemental Procedures – Compliments Power Policy in separating out Policy from Procedures.
