A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, ON BEHALF OF THE DOUGLAS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE BRIGHTON POLICE DEPARTMENT REGARDING THE SOTAR SEX OFFENDER PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID IGA ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 29-1-203 et seq., and § 29-20-105 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, governmental entities are authorized and encouraged to cooperate by contracting with one another to share in the costs of services or functions for their mutual benefit; and

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Sheriff's Office, has developed a system to manage and exchange information regarding sex offenders which is accessed through a web-based interactive software program called SOTARTM and Douglas County has exclusive rights and ownership of the SOTARTM system; and

WHEREAS, the Brighton Police Department wishes to retain access to the SOTARTM system; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes this action to be in the best interest of the citizens of Brighton.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Intergovernmental Agreement between the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, on Behalf of the Douglas County Sheriff's Office and the Brighton Police Department is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and deliver such agreement on behalf of the City in substantially the form presented at this meeting with such technical additions, deletions and variations as the City Attorney may deem necessary or appropriate and not inconsistent with this Resolution.
