

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING THE SIGNING OF A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH ADAMS COUNTY FOR THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$983,650.00), FOR THE “CFRT (COLORADO FRONT RANGE TRAIL) ALONG THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER” PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY’S MATCHING OBLIGATION OF FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TEN DOLLARS (\$567,410.00) AND PREVIOUS GRANT FUNDING RECEIVED IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION SIXTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS (\$1,060,470.00) FROM GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO AND COLORADO DIVISION OF PARKS AND WILDLIFE; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AND EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brighton determines that it was appropriate for the City to apply for an Adams County Open Space Grant, for the construction project entitled, “CFRT (Colorado Front Range Trail) Along the South Platte River” (the “Project”) for an amount not to exceed \$983,650.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton supports the completion of said Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton has received a grant for an amount not to exceed \$983,650.00 from Adams County to fund the Project, subject to the execution of a Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton City Council believes that it is reasonable and proper for the City to enter into a written agreement with Adams County for the budgeting, allocation and contribution of funds to the Project in the amounts contemplated herein; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton will be funding \$567,410.00 as a match to the Adams County grant, and the City will also be funding this project with \$950,000.00 from a Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO) grant funds received and \$110,470.00 from a Colorado Division of Parks and Wildlife – State Trails Grant funds received, and the anticipated total expense for the Project is \$2,611,530.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that said Grant Agreement is necessary and proper in order to proceed with the Project, and that it is in the best interests of the City to approve entering into such an Agreement for the Adams County Open Space grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes the City Manager to sign and execute the Grant Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council of the City of Brighton hereby authorizes the City Manager to sign and execute the Grant Agreement with Adams County for an amount not to exceed \$983,650.00 in grant funding for the project entitled “CFRT (Colorado Front Range Trail) Along the South Platte River”.
2. The City Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of funds as necessary to meet the terms and obligations of the Grant Agreement and Application, including without limitation, the City’s matching obligation of \$567,410.00 and previous grant funding from Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO) and Colorado Division of Parks and Wildlife in the amount of \$1,060,470.00.
3. This Resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
