

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-44

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF BOWMAN CONSULTING GROUP, LTD. FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED FORTY-SIX THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS (\$246,290.00) FOR STANDBY GENERATORS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City”), published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process to install six standby generators at four well sites, the Greensand Treatment Plant, and the North Water Storage Site in order to supply temporary emergency power in the event of a power failure, Project No. 22-007217.2 (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Bowman Consulting Group, Ltd., d/b/a PCD Engineering Services, a Bowman Company (“Bowman”) submitted a bid for the Project in the amount of \$246,290.00 (“Proposal”); and

WHEREAS, the City believes that Bowman is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies;” and

WHEREAS, Section 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Proposal of Bowman is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute the contract with Bowman for the Project on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective upon the date of its adoption.
