

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-132

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO,
SETTING THE 2023 CITY OF BRIGHTON HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the City Council provides twelve official holidays per calendar year for its employees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution 2021-89 establishing the holiday schedule for 2022, adding Juneteenth as a paid holiday and eighty hours of sick leave to the employee benefits package; and

WHEREAS, the City Council needs to determine the 2023 holiday schedule since certain holidays fall on weekends and the City Council must establish the observance dates for each holiday.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The twelve holidays for 2023 shall be the following:

New Year's Day	January 2
Martin Luther King Jr. Day	January 16
President's Day	February 20
Memorial Day	May 29
Juneteenth	June 19
Independence Day	July 4
Labor Day	September 4
Veterans Day	November 10
Thanksgiving Day	November 23
Day After Thanksgiving	November 24
Christmas Eve Day	December 25
Christmas Day	December 26

Section 2. This Resolution does not modify or rescind Resolution 2021-89, which remains in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
